July 31, 1940, by the Kurlash Co., Inc., from Rochester, N. Y.; and charging that it was misbranded in that its containers were so made, formed, or filled as to be misleading.

On September 30, 1940, no claimant having appeared, judgment of condemnation was entered and the product was ordered destroyed.

50. Misbranding of deodorant creams. U. S. v. 11½ Dozen Tubes of Fresh No. 1
Deodorant and 34½ Dozen Jars of Fresh No. 2 Non-Perspirant Vanishing
Cream. Default decrees of condemnation and destruction. (F. D. C. Nos. 869, 870. Sample Nos. 63895–D, 63897–D.)

The No. 1 Deodorant was contained in a tube which occupied only 20 percent of the capacity of the carton; and the No. 2 Non-Perspirant was packed in an opal glass jar having an exceedingly thick bottom which was one-half the total height of the jar.

On November 2, 1939, the United States attorney for the Eastern District of Missouri filed libels against certain quantities of the above-named products at St. Louis, Mo. On December 2, 1939, the libels were amended to cover $11\frac{1}{3}$ dozen tubes of Fresh No. 1 and $34\frac{1}{4}$ dozen jars of Fresh No. 2. It was alleged in the amended libels that the articles had been shipped in interstate commerce by the Pharma-Craft Corporation from Louisville, Ky., within the period from on or about July 18 to on or about October 27, 1939; and that they were misbranded in that their containers were so made, formed, or filled as to be misleading.

On March 19, 1940, the answers of the Pharma-Craft Corporation having been withdrawn with leave of court, and no other claimant having appeared, judgments of condemnation were entered and it was ordered that the products be destroyed.

PERMANENT WAVE SOLUTIONS

Nos. 51 to 57 report the seizure and disposition of a permanent waving method each unit of which consisted of a cardboard box holding one bottle each of a shampoo hair conditioner, a curling solution, and a neutralizing solution. Accompanying several of these units was a bottle labeled in part "Sealing Cream." The curling solution contained ammonium hydrogen sulfide, which would be injurious to users under customary conditions of use.
