## BEVERAGES AND BEVERAGE MATERIALS

5601. Adulteration of grapefruit-flavored beverage base. U. S. v. 9 Bottles of Grapefruit Flavored Beverage Base. Default decree of condemnation and destruction. (F. D. C. No. 12331. Sample No. 8442-F.)

On May 8, 1944, the United States attorney for the Western District of Wisconsin filed a libel against 9 bottles of grapefruit-flavored beverage base at Mineral Point, Wis., alleging that the article had been shipped on or about March 10, 1944, by the National Fruit Flavor Co., Inc., New Orleans, La.; and charging that it was adulterated in that it contained an added poisonous and deleterious substance, monochloracetic acid, which was unsafe within the meaning of the law, and in that it was an added poisonous and deleterious substance which was not required in the production of the article and could have been avoided by good manufacturing practice. It was labeled in part: "Grape-fruit Flavored Beverage Base 8-1."

On June 19, 1944, no claimant having appeared, judgment of condemnation was entered and the product was ordered destroyed.
