The shipper, claimant, having consented to the entry of a decree, judgment of condemnation was entered and the court ordered that the product be released under bond to be brought into compliance with the law by cracking the walnuts and by segregating the unfit portion, under the supervision of the Federal Security Agency.

The walnuts were cracked and shelled, and the unfit portion, amounting to 1,292 pounds, was denatured for use as oil stock for purposes other than for human consumption. 35,824 pounds, which were found fit for human consumption, were released to the claimant.
